#### **READING YOUR RESULTS**

This report summarizes the responses made by individuals who participated in the survey. The information below outlines how to read the results included in this report.

"PERSPECTIVE" refers to an identifiable group of respondents that have rated a given question.

**"ACTUAL"** refers to the total number of respondents who provided a *response* to a given question. Due to response variability, counts for "Actuals" across perspectives may not equal the total number of participants.

**"No Response(NR)"** refers to the number of respondents who left the question blank or provided a Neutral response. For purposes of this report, Neutral are considered the same as a "No Response".

"# of RESPONSES" refers to the number of "Actuals" who responded with a 1, 2, 4, & 5.

**"SD"** refers to the standard deviation. SD's greater than 1.5 indicate high variability across responses, and should be examined more closely.

"AVG" refers to the average (agreement) rating of all responses for a particular question.

Bar Charts are based on the following scale:

- "1" represents Strongly Disagree.
- "2" represents Disagree.
- "4" represents Agree.
- "5" represents Strongly Agree.

Please note that respondent who did not answer or provide a "3" Neutral response are included in the "No Response (NR)" category.
