I moved to Arlington over the summer, and I am very happy to now call it home. I do have one request that I feel will make the community a much safer place to live. Please install a "No parking from here to corner" where Mass ave intersects with Willow Ct. I moved to Willow Ct. over the summer and already have seen some accidents here. When exiting Willow Ct on to Mass Ave, It is very hard to see on-coming traffic, as cars are usually parked too close to Willow Ct. blocking the view of on-coming traffic. Installing a no parking from here to corner sign would only loose one parking space, but greatly increase safety for people exiting willow ct. There seems to be plenty of parking in this area - so loosing one parking space would have a nominal impact on the business here. There is also a day care, with many cars entering and exiting throughout the day with cars full of kids along with heavy foot traffic. Please see the attached map for proposed location of this sign. Every time I pull out of Willow Ct. I am holding my breath that I do not get hit by an oncoming car that is near-impossible to see. Please consider this for the safety of our community. 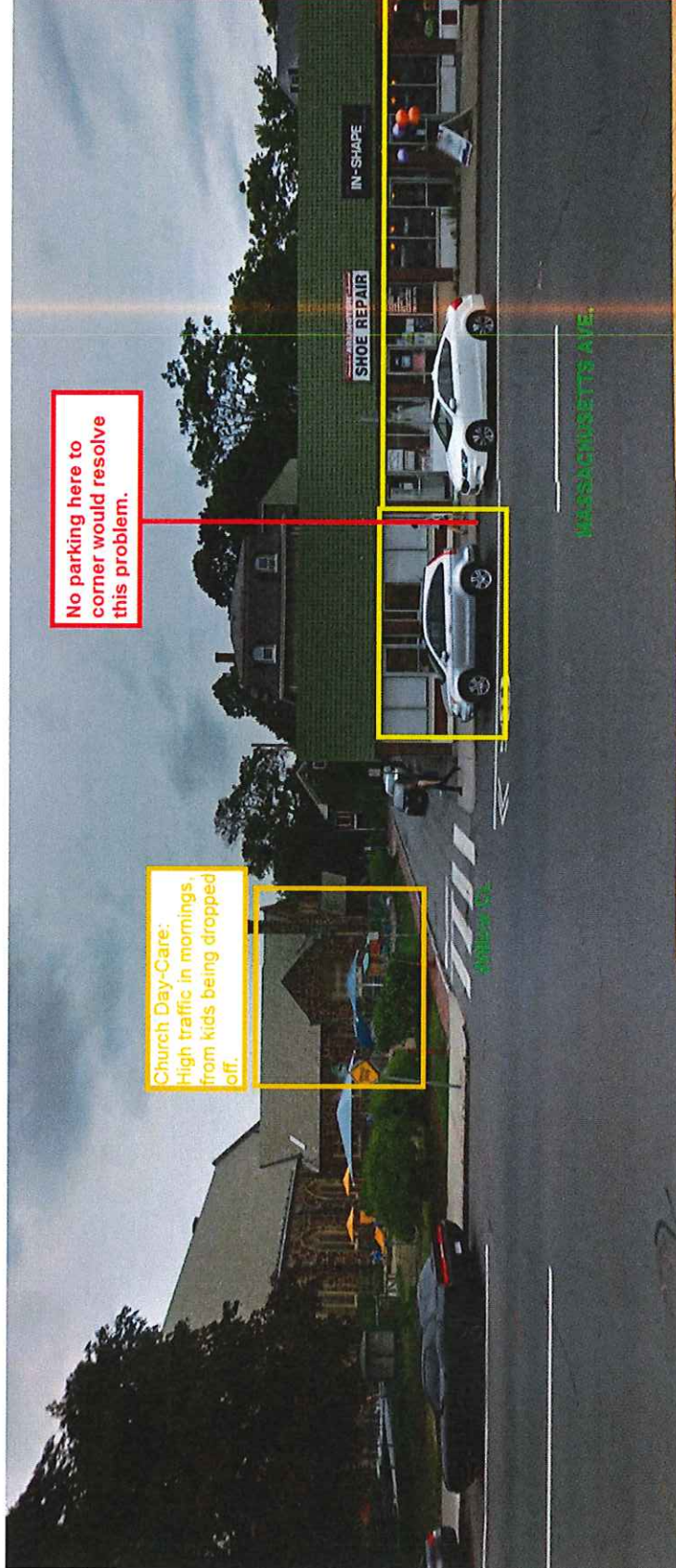
