Hardy parent – OT services were not being delivered, compensatory services promised by not delivered, was told it is a budget issue, staffing issue but OT there who can take another day, SPED Director put issue back on the school

Group of Bishop parents – classes of 25 or 26, not enough support, what is policy on providing TAs? Was told by other SC member the classes of 25+ get a TA but has not happened, never had a TA but 25 kids since 2nd grade, one TA shared by 3 first grade classes of 25, not sure that full time K TAs should get priority, wanted to know how to best advocate for more resources, consider more flexibility for resources rather than dedicating them to full time kindergarten TAs

Peirce parent – massive issues with bullying at Peirce – wants more resources in bullying prevention in lower grades. Hit or kicked on daily basis in kindergarten by one child – continued in first grade by other students. No formal complaint – was advised not to. Had to leave for private school. Sent letter in January. Does/should SC get report on # of bullying incidents?
