VOTED:

- 1 WHEREAS, the Town of Arlington wishes to encourage the use of its public libraries, and,
- 2. WHEREAS, the Town of Arlington values equal access to its public libraries for all citizens, with full regard for the economic diversity of the Town, and
- 3. WHEREAS, the American Library Association Bill of Rights urges that libraries operate in ways that "minimize distinctions among users based on their economic status or financial condition," and
- 4. WHEREAS, the most convenient Parking at Robbins Memorial Library is priced at \$1 per hour,
- 5. NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that Arlington Town Meeting encourages the Town to change the current parking fee system so that the most convenient parking is equally available to all, and,
- 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Town Meeting encourages the Town to accomplish this goal by eliminating the parking charge, or by reducing the parking charge to .25 per hour.
