September 12, 2019,

- Year 1 of the current Technology Plan called for the 3rd, 4th, and 5th Grades at the Peirce, Brackett, Dallin, and Bishop to receive new ChromeBook's and Carts for each Classroom at these Grade Levels.
- Purchased, provisioned, inventoried, and distributed 1000 ChromeBook's to the above mentioned Schools.
- Outfitted two new AHS Science Classrooms with 1 Windows Laptop Cart and 1 ChromeBook Cart along with Short Throw Projectors,
- Upgraded AHS Math Lab with 2 New ChromeBook Carts and new ChromeBook's
- All Schools, Except for AHS, have been upgraded to the New VOIP(Voice Over Internet Protocol) Telephony system. AHS is in the process of being scheduled.
- Replaced Aging PC's in the Ottoson Media Center with new ChromeBox's
- Issued 30 ChromeBook's and 10 iPads to the ELL department to be used District Wide
- Added 25 new iPads and Cart to the new First Grade Classroom at the Stratton.
- Increased the Districts Internet Bandwidth Capacity to 6 Gig that is made up of two 3 Gig redundant circuits, one located at the Ottoson Middle School and one located at AHS.
- Removed Older Chromebooks and Carts from the Four Elementary Schools that were upgraded this Summer so they could be reprovisioned to area's throughout the District.
- Upgraded PowerSchool to most recent version to take advantage of enhanced security features.
