I am writing to you all to ask you to please add his fatal accident to the agenda for the Arlington Selectboard meeting on Monday. I frequently rode my own bike with Charlie, and have never met a safer or kind cyclist. It is incredibly tragic that something awful had to happen for this intersection to be re-examined, but as an honor to Charlie I am asking you to please consider making it safer for all who pass through it. The proposed modifications would increase visibility and safety at the intersection of the crash and five other similarly configured intersections. The hope is that no one else will be harmed due to any of these intersections.
