I am urging the town to place signs along the path indicating bikers to signal when passing. My estimate is that about 10% of bikers announce when they pass, and some are moving so fast (and sometimes recklessly) that I think it's only a matter of time before someone is seriously injured due to a collision. Walking or jogging the path should be fun, it's not anymore, when you feel vulnerable.
