RE: Request: Third Space, On Street Resident Parking Permit at 18 Swan Place

At your request, the Arlington Police Department Traffic and Parking Unit looked into the petition by the resident at 18 Swan Place to be permanently issued a third parking permit. Upon examining the petition and reviewing the area, the Traffic and Parking Unit **does not** support the issuance of a third permit based on the following reasons:

18 Swan Place is a two-family residence with no deeded driveway. There is currently enough frontage to the property to fit two motor vehicles. Due to the layout of the street, the close proximity of adjacent properties, and the locations of nearby driveways, issuing a third resident parking permit, even if it was allowed under current regulations, would permanently deny nearby residences the ability to have an overnight guest vehicle parked in front of their property in conformance with Town regulations.

Swan Street has ample timed parking that is available to residents. Additionally, the Lamson Way and Russell Common municipal parking lots are in close proximity.
