 - 7) Respecting all constituencies
 - 8) Laughing a lot
 - 9) Assuming good intentions
 - 10) Modeling desired behaviors
 - 11) Celebrating the work in the field
 - 12) Practicing often the decorum of held dignity
 - 13) Allowing space for multiple member perspectives
