Hi, I am a 20+ year resident of the town and have followed this development closely over the past year or so. I live on the opposite side of town from the proposed development, and I do not personally know anyone that lives in the immediate vicinity of the proposal. I think with every passing year we see the effect of dense urban areas on the local climate, from the heat island effect to the flooding everyone knows will happen, as well as the increase of traffic on Lake Street, causing even more cars to sit and toss toxic fumes into the air.

Not all development is a bad idea but if any development was a bad idea this one would be near the top of the list.

I realize that the town has taken some previous steps in the past to challenge some of the developers assertions which allow them to build this in this location but I believe the town can do more and should actually do much more.
