



Strategy Highlights:

- Diversify and expand program offerings for teens, tweens, and adults, including exploring options for intergenerational or family events
- Expand co-creation of programs and events, using community expertise and partner resources more fully

GOAL 2: INCREASE LIBRARY ACCESS FOR AND USE BY ALL COMMUNITY MEMBERS


Strategy Highlights:

- Regularly reevaluate and where possible expand hours of operation with specific attention to weekends, Thursdays, and Fox Branch Library
- Partner with the Arlington Public Schools to increase the number of schoolchildren with library cards and expand use of library services by children
