
Overview of the Data

- From 9/19-4/22, there has been one out of school suspension among all elementary schools
- During the 20-21 school year students participated in a hybrid/remote form of instruction that resulted in reduced class sizes

Behavior Support


- Elementary Staff continue to implement Responsive Classroom (RC)
 - Both basic RC and advanced RC training courses are being offered this summer to elementary staff
- K-5 Second Step curriculum has been adopted for explicit SEL instruction
- Bishop, Hardy, and Thompson schools are participating in the Multi Tiered Systems of Support Academy for Positive Behavior Intervention and Support
- We have hired an SEL coach who has been spending time in classrooms modeling lessons and providing guidance for supporting students
- Hiring of full time assistant principals at each elementary school
- Use of Panorama student data results to target areas of concern


