RE: Authorizing the Police Details for the State Election

The new Votes Act requires a Select Board vote to authorize the necessary police details for each election. Officers are required at each polling location under G.L. Chapter 54, Section 72 on election day. Officers are optional during in-person early voting, however it has been Arlington's practice to have an officer detailed to Town Hall during early voting. An additional change in the law applies the 150-foot rule prohibiting election signs during early voting hours as well, making the need for an officer more important. I ask the Board to take the following vote:

Voted: that the Town Manager and Police Chief are directed to assign sufficient police details to preserve order and protect election officers as required by G.L. c. 54 sec. 72:

- At Town Hall for early voting Saturday October 22, 2022 through November 4, 2022 during those hours enumerated; and
- At the nine (9) polling locations on November 8, 2022 between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.
