WHEREAS: Mr. Chunglo has been awarded the Meritorious Service Medal, Navy and Marine Corps Commendation Medal, Navy, and Marine Corps Achievement Medal (7), Navy Unit Commendation Medal (2), Global War on Terrorism Medal, and multiple personal and unit awards; and
