Hello

We have Do Not Enter signs posted on Lake St that prevent entry from 7 am – 9 am and 4 pm to 7 pm off Lake St onto Wilson Ave, Littlejohn St., and Homestead Rd.

As a resident on Mary St, I appreciate the recent enforcement actions. It prevents a lot of cut-through traffic of people racing down Mary St to Margert St.

But as resident, I don't want to have to crawl all the way down to Burch St before I can legally turn into my neighborhood. The police officers who have been ticketing report that the vast majority of tickets that they are writing (33 of 38, according to the officer who ticketed my husband) are being issued to people who live in the neighborhood.

What can we do to allow residents of the neighborhood to legally turn in and get home without adding to the Lake St. mess?
