Open Meeting

Mr. Thielman welcomed Jason Levey, AEA President and Matt Coleman to the meeting.

Math Curriculum Presentation

Mr. Matt Coleman, Director of Math for K-12 provided an update on the goals for the current year and on Response Training Initiative RTI and spoke how the Math coaches work with students, regular education and special education teachers on implementing new curriculum and long term planning and are working in cycles on professional development and lessons with all level teachers. Mr. Coleman commented that students are looking for more computer science courses especially for those in Grade 6-8.

Dr. Allison-Ampe asked how Mr. Coleman sees the curriculum shifting for the Gibbs and he noted that we all have an opportunity to think and create how the Math curriculum will integrate for the students while maintaining and supporting the social and emotional aspect of it all.

AHS Internship Program Presentation

Ms. Melanie Konstandakis-Schwartz presented a presentation listing the Overarching Vision, Student Goals and Vision, and the Changes and Updates of the Internship Program at Arlington High School, which is in its fifth year, and this year having the largest group of students in the program. Arlington High student Sreeshti C explained her computer science internship at The Computer Café here in Arlington. Sreeshti learned how to repair and rebuild computers, fix software problems, fix corrupted hard drives and helped build a new computer system too. Her final project was designing a website for a restaurant which the customer appreciated. The

many students and business owners end the internship program with a large ceremony, where all students receive awards and the business receive certificate of appreciation. Since more students are learning about the program junior class students will start to take part in the program next year. The committee members were impressed with this program.

Searches

Assistant Superintendent

Dr. Bodie wanted to recognize and thank Dr. Chesson especially since the School Committee members of the Groton Dunstable completed their Superintendent Search and voted and signed the contract of Dr. Laura Chesson and will start there July 1, 2017. Dr. Chesson thanked the school committee members and the team of professionals here in Arlington.

Dr. Bodie announced we will search for an Assistant Superintendent and have invited the AEA union, AAA union, curriculum leaders, an AEF member and a School Committee member to serve on the committee with interviews taking place in about two weeks. Mr. Hayner volunteered to serve on the committee.

Dr. Allison-Ampe moved to appoint Mr. Hayner as the school committee representative to serve on the search committee for the Assistant Superintendent, seconded by Ms. Susse. Voted: 6-0

Ottoson Middle School Principal search

Dr. Bodie informed the committee she does not have three candidates to bring forward yet for the OMS principal position. Mr. Hayner suggested that Dr. Bodie consider our current principal and asked if we would seek a waiver to keep Dr. Woods here for another year. Dr. Bodie will keep the committee members updated.

Gibbs Search

Dr. Bodie announced back in December she would do an internal search for the Gibbs Principal position since she knew that we have talent in our district and that this someone has been involved with teachers and curriculum leaders, and has well established relationships. Since we had one candidate apply she is pleased that Kristin DeFrancisco from the Hardy will become the Gibbs Principal since she is qualified. Dr. Chesson and Ms. DeFranciso will co-chair the Gibbs Planning committee present to parent sand the Vision 2020 committee in June 13, at Town Hall, and to the school committee members in the fall. Ms. DeFrancisco will provide Responsive Classroom training two full days in August for all 6th Grade teachers. Kristin will receive a stipend for the Gibbs Principal position for the 2017-2018 school years.

The search continues for the Director of Performing Arts, Director of World Language and Director of Guidance, and Social and Emotional.

The Arlington High School Building committee went to Winchester High Sschool and toured with 10 members of our committee lead by the current principal. The school was beautiful school and not completed yet but they mentioned a few things not to do and it was nice function to see how it was done in intervals.
